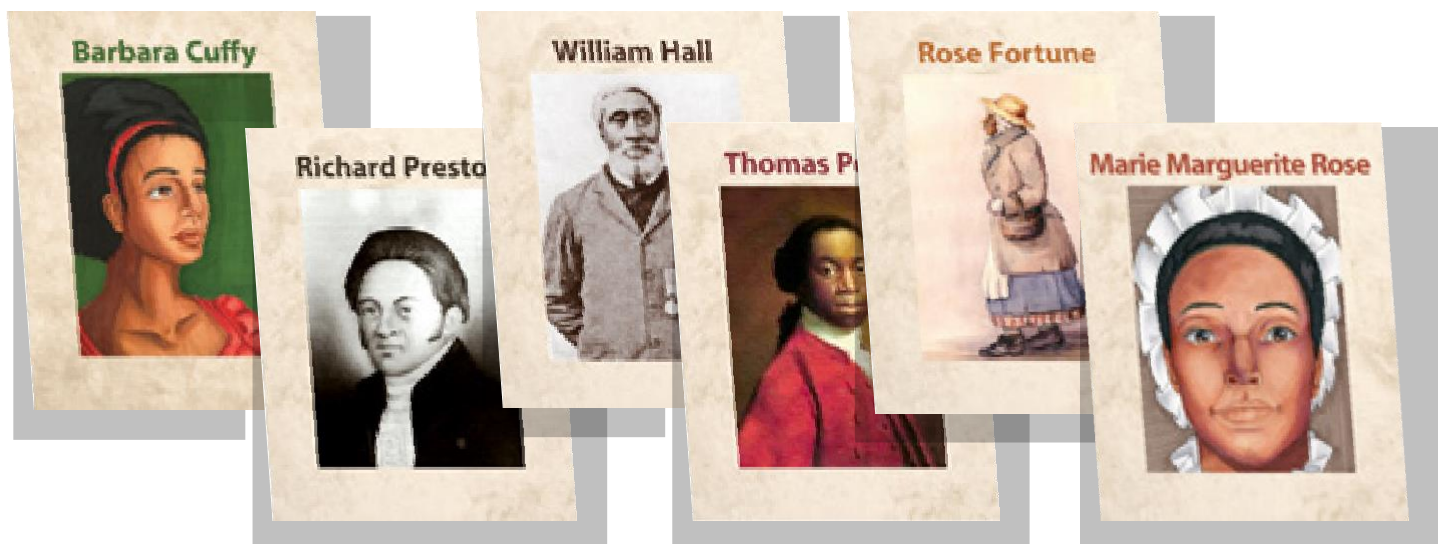




Our History is Nova Scotia's History - Profiles

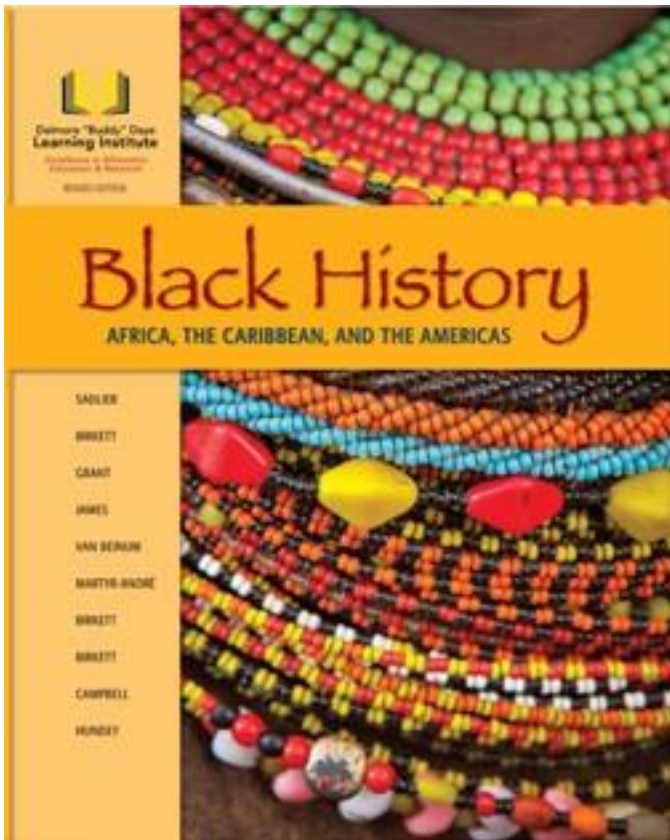

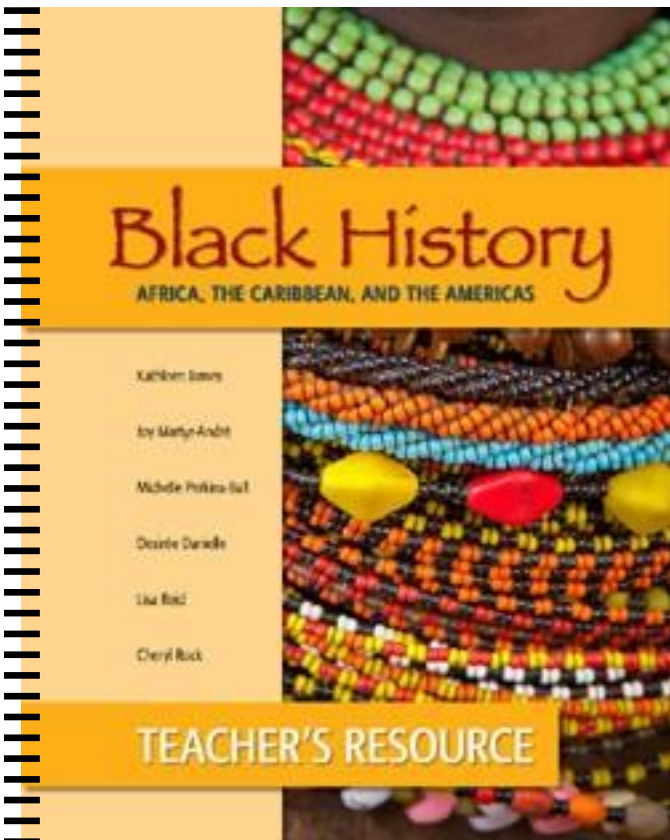
Black History: Africa, the Caribbean, and the Americas

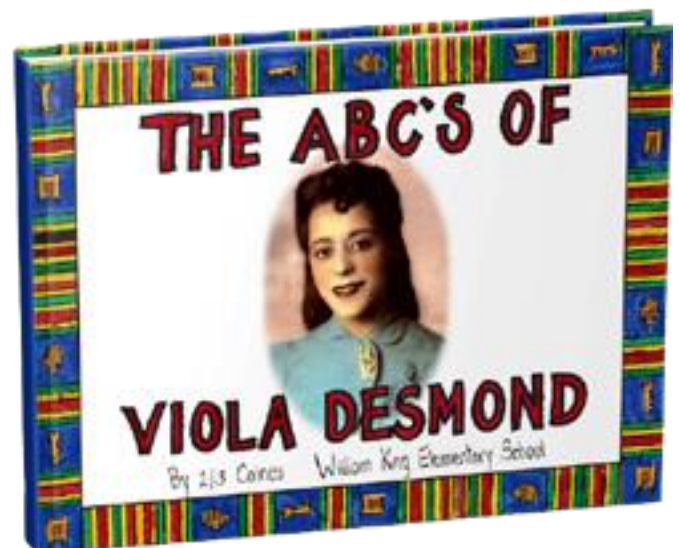

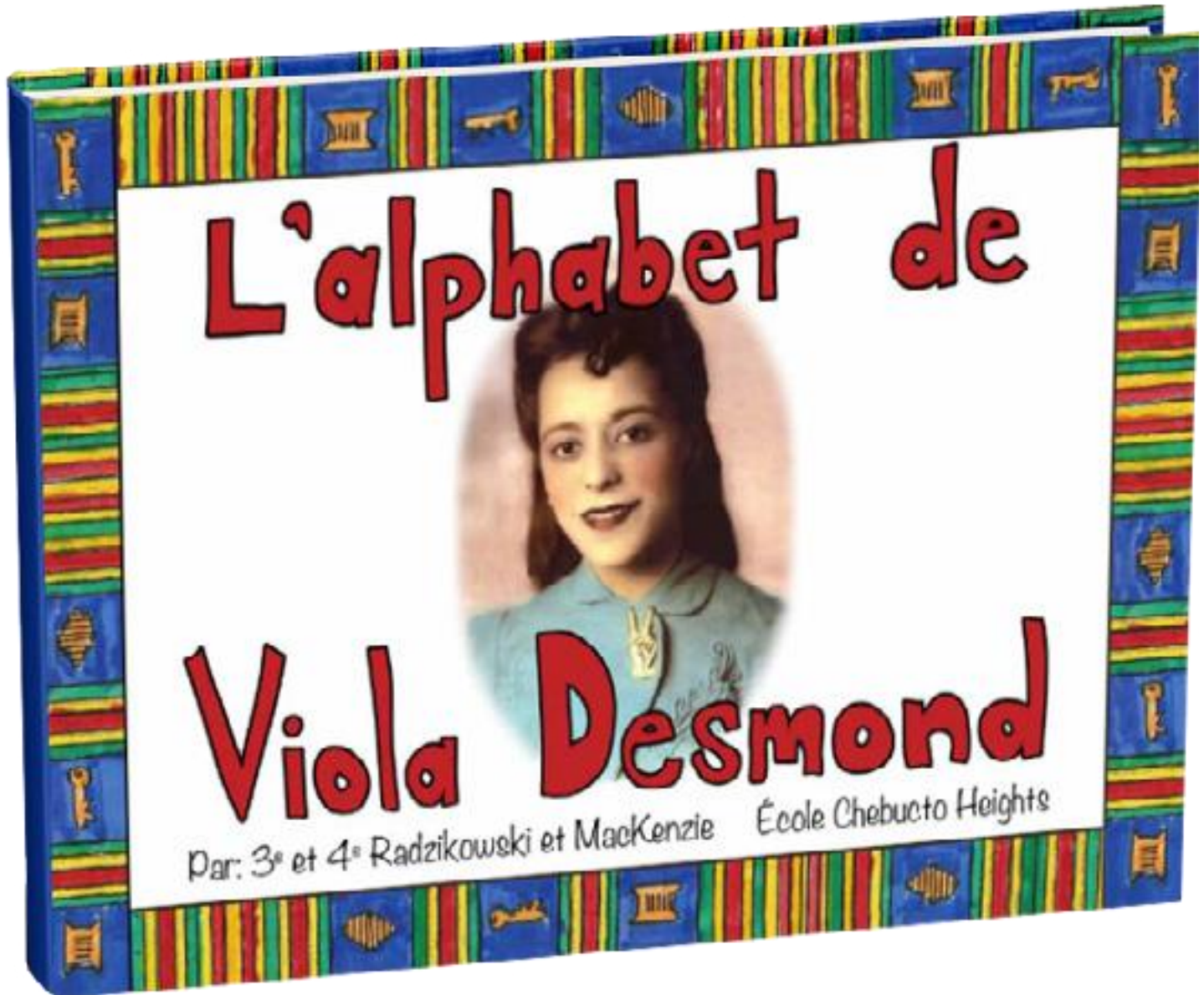

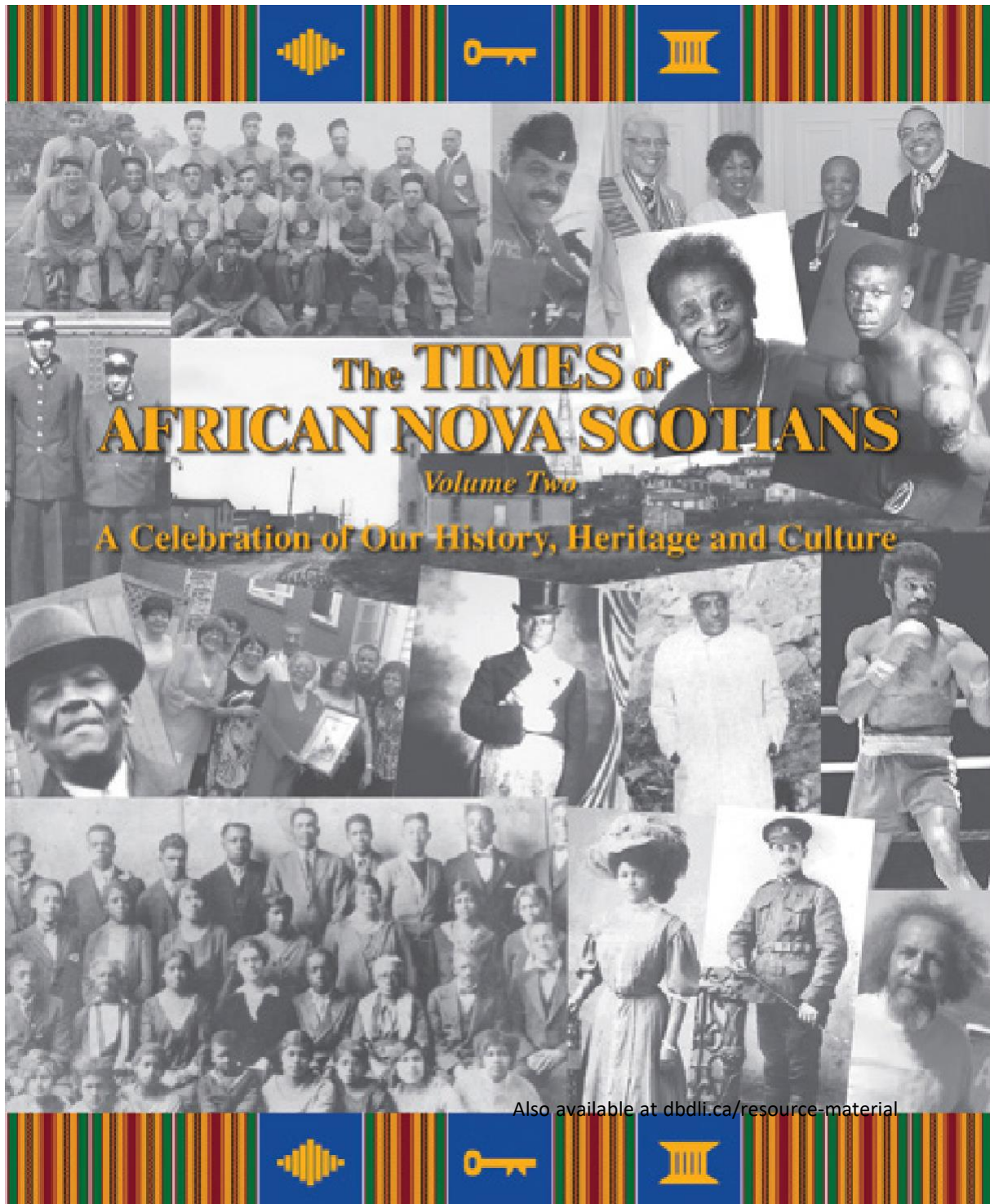

Q is for Quarantine: The ABCs of COVID-19

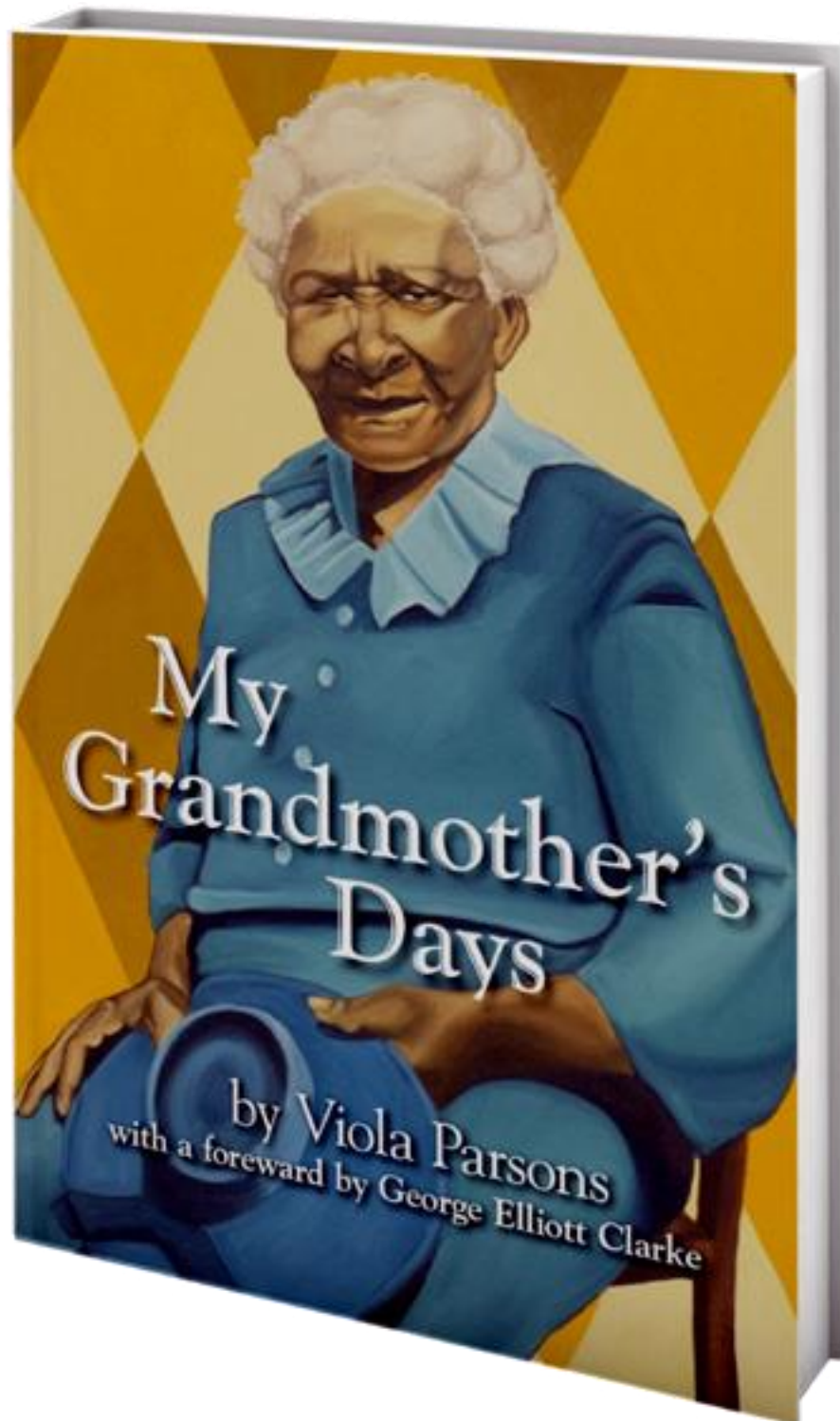

My Grandmother's Days



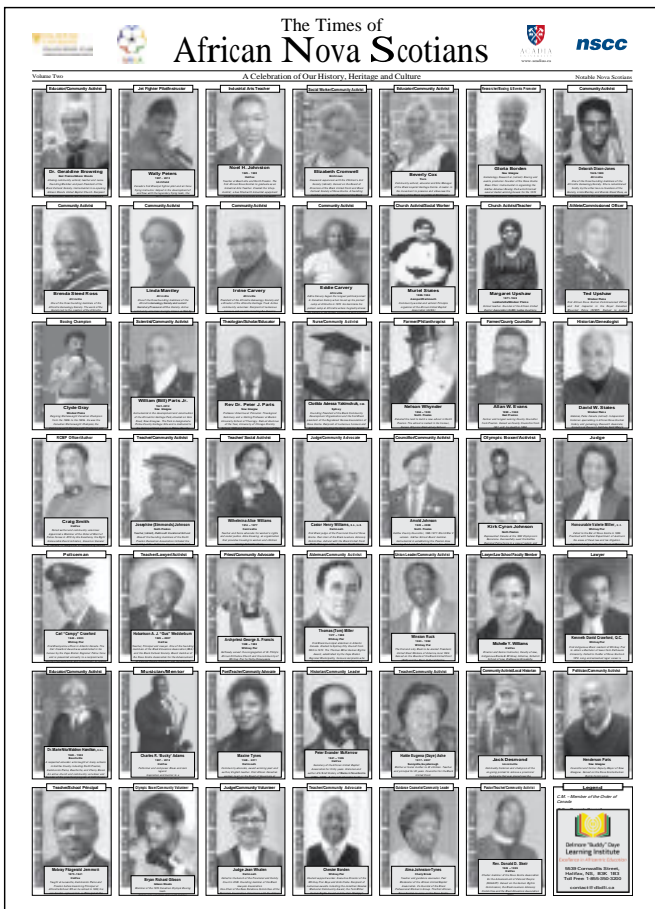
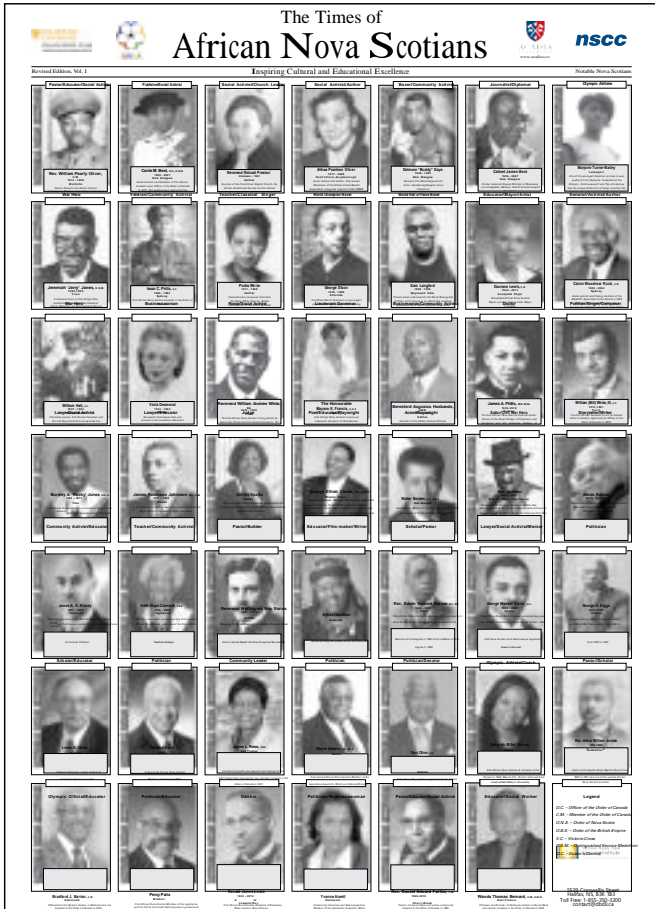
